FREE RECYCLING BAGS are going to be delivered to you in July.

To help you organise your kitchen, we are giving you two free re-usable, wipe-clean bags which will make it easier for you to store your recycling and carry it down to the recycling facilities.



These have been paid for as part of the European Union LIFE + Project Up and Forward; a joint project with the Greater Manchester Waste Disposal Authority (GMWDA) which aims to make recycling easier.

Common Questions

I may not be in to received my recycling bags

If we miss you we will call back and try again. If you do not receive your recycling bags then we will let you know where these can be collected from.

When can I start using my recycling bags, caddy and liners?

Start using your recycling bags, caddy and liners as soon as they arrive.

Here's a reminder about using the recycling bins.

There's a full set of recycling facilities located outside the ground floor or basement entrance of your block of flats.



BLUE BIN: Any paper, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, catalogues, envelopes, all types of cardboard, telephone directories, cards, cartons (such as juice or soup cartons) and even shredded paper.



GREEN BIN: Plastic bottles, glass bottles, glass jars, food tins, drinks cans, empty aerosols, aluminium foil and foil trays (but no other plastics please). Please remember to remove lids before recycling.

Important

Please make sure that the only plastics you put in the green bin are plastic bottles, and please **don't** put any plastic carrier bags in any of the recycling bins. **If you put the wrong stuff in the wrong bins then the recycling collected from all the flats may have to go to landfill.**



NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS

Please **DO NOT** leave any bulky waste near the outside bin area.
