



Free recycling bags, food waste caddy and compostable liners

To help you organise your kitchen, we are giving you a free re-usable, wipe-clean bag which will make it easier for you to store your recycling and carry it down to the bin area. The bag is split to help you separate your recycling for the beige and burgundy bin. We are also giving you a food waste caddy and compostable liners so you can recycle your food waste and leftovers.

Common Questions

I haven't received my recycling bags, caddy and liners.

If you have not received your recycling bag, caddy and liners and would like to take part in recycling please contact... At Bolton at Home who can arrange for them to be dropped off.

I have a large item which does not fit into any of the bins, what should I do?

Contact a local charity to donate if in good quality or arrange for Bolton Council to collect if not. If possible take to the local Household Waste Recycling Centre who will dispose of it for free.

When can I start using my recycling bags, caddy and liners?

Start using your recycling bags, caddy and liners as soon as they arrive.

I have used all my liners, how do I get some more?

Visit the One Stop Shop at Bolton Town Hall or the UCAN Centres for replacement rolls of liners.

Here's a reminder about using the recycling bins.

There's a set of recycling facilities...

BEIGE BIN: Any paper, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, catalogues envelopes all types of cardboard, telephone directories, cards, cartons (such as juice or soup cartons) and even shredded paper.

BURGUNDY BIN: plastic bottles, glass bottles, glass jars, food tins, drinks cans, empty aerosols, aluminium foil and foil trays (but no other plastics please).

GREEN BIN: Food waste / dead flowers etc.

If you put the wrong stuff in the wrong bins then the recycling collected from all the flats may have to go to landfill.



Large Items – Why dump when you can donate!

Good Quality items: such as sofas, armchairs, beds, headboards, wardrobes, chests of drawers, TV stands, dining tables and chairs, side tables, sideboards and study desks – Bolton Community Transport will arrange for prompt collection. Contact them on 01204 364777. They will also collect free of charge from the Bolton area any washers, cookers or dryers working or not. However, there is a charge to collect refrigeration items such as fridges and freezers due to current recycling regulations. Please do not leave good quality items outside as they will not be collected.

Non-Useable Items: Bolton Council will collect for a small fee or they can be taken to the Local Household Waste Recycling Centre at.... (Please be aware that if you take items in a van you will be asked for proof that you are a Bolton resident and not a business such as a council tax bill or van rental agreement).

Please do not leave the bulky items or large cardboard boxes beside the recycling area. **This is fly-tipping, which is a criminal offence.**

NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS

Please **DO NOT** throw items out of the windows, there is CCTV in operation and anyone caught throwing things out of the window will be dealt with accordingly.

CHUTES – No nappies, cooking fat and oil!

Do not throw nappies, fat and cooking oil down the chutes as they become blocked and lead to smell and flies. Put nappies into a plastic bag and put into the blue bin and cooking fat and oil down the drain.
