
Do you live in Stonemill Terrace? We are making recycling easier for you.

Free recycling bags, food waste caddy and liners

To help you organise your kitchen, we are giving you two free re-usable, wipe-clean bags which will make it easier for you to store your recycling and carry it down to the bin store. We have also given you a food waste caddy and liners so you can recycle your food waste and leftovers.

Common Questions

I haven't received my recycling bags, caddy and liners or my bin has been lost or stolen

If you haven't received your recycling bag, caddy or liners then please contact your caretaker Pete Wooding or Paul Bowell by going to the Stonemill main office.

When can I start using my recycling bags, caddy and liners?

Start using your recycling bags, caddy and liners as soon as they arrive.

I have used all my liners, how do I get some more?

Each resident will receive a roll of 150 liners from Stockport Council every year, however if more are needed, they can be purchased from local supermarkets, please make sure they are **compostable**. If you did not receive these please contact **Pete Wooding or Paul Bowell** the caretaker.

Here's a reminder about using the recycling bins.

There's a set of recycling facilities in all chute rooms as well as new food waste bins located between Stonemill and the Bentleys.

BLUE BIN: Any paper, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, catalogues envelopes all types of cardboard, telephone directories, cards, cartons (such as juice or soup cartons) and even shredded paper.

BROWN BIN: plastic bottles, glass bottles, glass jars, food tins, drinks cans, empty aerosols, aluminium foil and foil trays (but no other plastics please).

GREEN BIN: Food waste / dead flowers etc.

Important

Please make sure that the only plastics you put in the brown bin are plastic bottles, and please **don't** put any plastic carrier bags in any of the recycling bins. **If you put the wrong stuff in the wrong bins then the recycling collected from all the flats may have to go to landfill.**



Large Items

I have a large item which does not fit into any of the bins, what should I do?

Check with your caretaker Pete Wooding and Paul Bowell for advice on where to leave your things for collection. Make sure you've booked a collection before taking them to the bin store. Please do not leave the bulky items or large cardboard boxes beside the recycling area. **This is fly-tipping, which is a criminal offence.**

NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS

Please **DO NOT** throw items out of the windows, we have CCTV in operation and anyone caught throwing things out of the window will be dealt with accordingly.

CHUTE ROOMS

Please **DO NOT** leave rubbish on the floor in any of the chute rooms dispose of these in the designated bin.

If you have any large items of rubbish **DO NOT** leave these in the chute rooms or try to dispose of them that way. Please contact the onsite caretaker who will advise you on what to do with them. Please be aware CCTV cameras are located in all chute rooms any items left or not disposed of correctly will be reported.
